As I write this, we await the confirmation by Council of the unanimous recommendation of the Christian Education Committee for our next Director of Christian Education--we are very excited--stay tuned! We are also approaching our first \$1000 raised for World Central Kitchen, to

benefit the people of Ukraine--both those still in the country and those who have fled to border regions--our efforts here have a direct impact on the suffering of our brothers and sisters in Eastern Europe. By the time you read this, we will have celebrated the end of a reflective and growth inducing Lent, the Alleluias of Easter Morning, and starting our journey together of the Great Fifty Days of Easter that carries us now until Pentecost on June 4--what does God have in store for us??!

This year as we look at stewardship together in the Easter season, we do so perhaps with a new sense of just how blessed we are--and--what a DIFFERENCE a small but committed congregation can make in God's world! Just as Lent was different, perhaps deeper and richer for many of us--so too, I pray, the Easter season will newly inspire our following the Risen One!
