The Church Office remains closed.

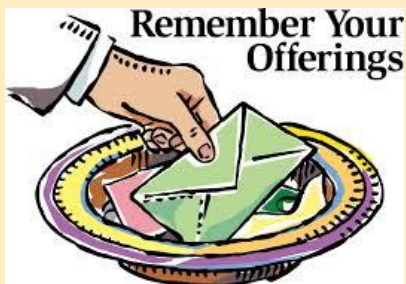
